**TRANSFER TO ITI CAPITAL LIMITED - UPDATE**  
**31 JULY 2020**

In the Joint Special Administrators' ("JSAs") last update to clients dated 28 July 2020, we stated that ITI Capital Limited ("ITI") had informed the JSAs that it was experiencing technical issues which was preventing ITI's clients from logging into the client registration system. Based on the information provided by ITI, the JSAs duly advised clients that ITI were seeking to resolve this issue within 48 hours. That period has now elapsed. The JSAs have subsequently been made aware that these technical issues are continuing and in some instances go beyond the client registration system.

ITI has informed the JSAs that a variety of fixes to resolve these issues will take place over the course of this coming weekend. The JSAs will continue to engage with ITI during this period and will provide a further update on 3 August 2020.
